Please name your child's items before sending them to school with the exception of workbooks.

The school has negotiated competitive prices for quality materials through Campion Education (Aust) Pty Ltd. Whilst you are not obliged to use our preferred supplier, we encourage you to purchase from this company as it provides quality products and service. Please note the following:

- The totals above include an IT contribution (which includes an iPad and IT support contribution) of \$25.00 per student in Pre-Primary to Year 3, and \$50.00 per child in Year 4 to Year 6.
- The total costs listed above comprise the booklist stationery items and workbooks in addition to the IT contribution. They do not include voluntary contributions (see below).
- The total cost of the booklists will be slightly less than the total cost shown above, as two types of scissors are listed (left and right-handed) and only one type is required to be purchased.
- · All workbooks are included on the booklist as an item. Your child will receive these in their bag of stationery.

Please do not write on or cover these books as changes may be made regarding the level your child is working at.

- The Year 4, 5 and 6 Booklists include a Yamaha Descant Recorder. If your child has already purchased a Recorder in Year 4, please retain for use in Year 5 and 6.
- PP to Year 6 booklists include headphones. These must be the over-ear type, not the ear bud type. Please retain these year-to-year.
- An opportunity to order a Graduation Shirt is made available to Year 6 students each year. The cost incurred is kept to a minimum and generally does not exceed \$40.00

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS & CHARGES

Also included in this letter is an outline of the **maximum** anticipated costs for Contributions and Charges you **might** be asked to pay, during 2026. It is important that you are completely aware that these are only **anticipated** costs.

CONTRIBUTIONS

The School Board, which is made up of parents and staff, with parents having the majority voting rights, has considered the level of contribution needed to provide necessary additional student/school resources, materials and activities to enhance the educational program. The actual costs per child are shown in the table below. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of the teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other resources, including State and Commonwealth Governments.

P&C VOLUNTARY APPROVED CONTRIBUTION

Over many years the P&C, the official parent/carer organisation of the school, has provided many resources for school, along with direct subsidies to specific student activities. On average over the past five years, support from the P&C has been between \$10,000 and \$20,000 per year.

To keep this support going the P&C is continuing to seek a voluntary contribution of **\$25.00** per family. This revenue will be complemented by a range of fundraising activities. The assistance provided by the P&C benefits **all students** in the school.

Both the School Voluntary Contribution and the Voluntary P&C Contribution can be paid as part of the 'personal items' list.

CHARGES FOR EXTRA OPTIONAL COMPONENTS

Charges are costs incurred for optional components of educational activities such as in-term swimming lessons, school visits, excursions, sporting events, camps etc.
